Total hospital amounts; Hospital type by percentage (private vs. public); Level of care provided by hospitals; Total number of beds; Bed types broken out by percentage; Amount of hospitals with different bed types (from <5 beds to 90+ beds); Amount of operating rooms;

Amount of ICUs; Amount of PICUs; Amount of NICUs; Penetration of EMRs, PACS, RIS, telemedicine, homecare monitoring; Base installed equipment penetration rates (anesthesia machines, ventilators, C-arms, colposcopes: a total of 25 equipment categories are covered); Growth rates for base installed equipment, 2018-2019 (absolute amounts of base installed equipment in 2018 for all hospitals in a country vs. absolute amounts in 2019 and growth/contraction rate);
